Parcel Tax Notification:

Due to rising costs of doing capital projects within our community, the Trustees have made the decision to raise the parcel tax more than you would normally see in a year. The increase is \$75 more than last year. Please remember that the purpose of collecting revenue is that it is to be used towards the operating and capital costs for the water system infrastructure.
