At present, there are now 12 active fire fighters. The fire department has had some members complete the following courses: a) Air Brakes b) Flagging c) OFA – Level 1. With more coming.

Also, the Department and the HID is in search of at least 3 or more community volunteers to become **Certified First Responders**. This is a **week-long** course, so a commitment is required. The classes will take place in another town/city and the HID/FD will fund it on the understanding that the people trained will be expected to be **on-call 24/7**. Therefore, the qualified personnel **MUST** be ready to assist in any medical situation with the aid of the Fire Department.
