## **\*\*Notice to Recreational Fire Permit Holders\*\***

1. Upon issuance of this Recreational Fire Permit, the permit holder named above accepts responsibility and liability involved in the open kindling of this recreational fire. The holder agrees to use common sense and respect for his/her neighbours while utilizing this permit. **Bylaw 215** (Hedley Improvement District Fire Regulations) permits this recreational fire and is subject to several conditions as outlined in Bylaw 215.

## **REQUIREMENTS OF HEDLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FIRE REGULATIONS BYLAW 215**

**EVERYTHING IS PROHIBITED - EXCEPT - SEASONED FIREWOOD-MUST Have a HOSE/Water Source Nearby.**

2. "Recreational Fires" are defined as the burning of seasoned firewood or other fuel approved by the fire chief or a designee where the fuel being burned is contained within a device or pit approved by the fire chief or agent. **Charcoal and gas burning appliances are not considered as recreational fires. Propane devices are ALLOWED.**
3. An annual permit is required in order to maintain a recreational fire and is issued at no charge.
4. Recreational fires cannot be located within 3 meters (10 feet) of a structure, nor within 3 meters (10 feet) of an existing property line, except when specifically authorized by the fire chief or a designee.
5. Recreational fires shall not exceed 1 meter (3 feet) in diameter and the flame height shall not exceed 1 meter (3 feet) from the ground surrounding the device or pit.

## **6. BURN BARRELS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

7. Recreational fires are permitted only on property used and occupied as a private dwelling.
8. Fires must always be attended and extinguishing equipment be nearby.
9. Recreation fires are **not** permitted during Forestry Service fire bans. Gas and charcoal burning appliances are permitted.
10. Any permit issued under Bylaw 215 may be withheld or suspended by the highest-ranking fire officer on duty if the officer determines the fire is a hazard or nuisance to persons or property in the vicinity.
11. This Recreational Burning Permit shall be in effect from January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>.

- a) Trees/Parts of Trees -Branches/Prunings/Trunks/,Stumps/Other Vegetation that is not compostable including HOPS.
- b) Animal Carcasses/Waste from slaughtering
- c) Asphalt or asphalt products
- d) Batteries
- e) Biomedical Waste
- f) Cardboard
- g) Carpets/Rugs
- i) Drywall
- j) Tires
- k) Construction Waste other than lumber that has NOT been treated with wood preservatives or other chemicals and not coated with paint, varnish, oil, finishing material or glue
- L) Demolition Waste
- m) Domestic Waste
- n) Electric Wires
- o) Fibreglass or fibre-reinforced polymers
- p) Fuel and lubricant containers
- q) Furniture and Appliances
- r) Hazardous Materials
- s) Manure
- t) Paint/Varnish/ finishing material or glue/Oil
- u) Paper Products
- v) Plastics
- w) Polystyrene Foam
- x) Railway Ties
- z) Tar/Tar Paper
- A1) Rubber
- B2) Treated/Painted wood products
- C3) Used Oil
